

This monograph provides a study of the Old-Babylonian Mesopotamia sheep-farming labour organisation also thanks to the data give us from the *bullae* or tags. After a general survey of the morphological and typological aspects of the tags, all the 123 animal tags hitherto published are collected and discussed in order to offer a possible reconstruction of the contexts in which the animal tags were used. Besides, all the shepherds' names mentioned in the animal tags are listed, both individually and in connection to the animals; likewise, all the animals and all the words mentioned in the animal tags are listed.
